Job Description for: Community Health Worker (CHW)

Compensation: Starting at \$17.00 per/ hour

This is a part time (20 hrs. /week) position

CHW provides program services to community members, performs client/community assessments, program reporting, reports to Coalition Deputy Director, and performs program tasks assigned.

Required:

High school diploma, or certification of equivalence, strong work ethics and self-motivated, knowledge of MS office products, good organizational, communication and documentation skills, Candidates are not required to hold medical based knowledge. CHW course completion certification is required within 3 months of hire.

Preferred:

- Associate's degree
- Knowledge of HIPAA, personal rights and client confidentiality.
- Culturally competent
- Bilingual
- Have a desire to help their community
- Able to communicate well and build rapport with other community members
- Empathy: responsive to the needs of others
- Out-going personality
- Ability to travel
- Flexible work schedule, schedule will vary each week depending on community events, program needs and trainings.
- Ability to work occasional weekends and evenings at community events.
- CIT; ASIST, or similar; Mental Health First Aid/ Youth Mental Health First Aid

CHW Roles and Responsibilities:

Perform client needs assessment, connect clients with local services, provide group and/or individual education, perform outreach, make referrals to local resources, Health and Mental Health Centers and other organizations, and follow up with those referred, perform data collection, and program reporting, and all other tasks assigned by the Deputy Director. **CHWs are responsible for documenting their work and protecting confidentiality.** They also perform and report community assessments.

This position requires several forms of training, and candidates must be able to attend potential weekend trainings, with potential travel.

Compensation: Start @ \$17.00/hr., 20 hrs. /week

This position is grant-funded, and therefore may not continue past the life of the grant.
